

DISCIPLINARY COMPLAINT RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

pursuant to section 55(2)(a.1) of the *Health Professions Act*

BETWEEN:

KURTIS KOZYRA, #110,702
(the “**Registrant**”)

and

College of Registered Nurses of Alberta
(the “**College**”)

A Disciplinary Complaint Resolution Agreement (“**DCRA**”) was executed between the Registrant and the College, dated with effect May 1, 2024. The below constitutes a summary of such DCRA:

Through an Agreement with the College, KURTIZ KOZYRA, #110,702 (the “**Registrant**”), acknowledged and admitted that their behaviour constituted unprofessional conduct. Particulars of the Registrant’s unprofessional conduct arises from one (1) complaint to the College include the following:

- Between approximately August 2023 and November 2023, the Registrant:
- The Registrant failed to practice competently in a correctional setting when they failed to conduct mental health assessments on patients post use of force.
- The Registrant misrepresented in their documentation patient care related to mental health assessments including charting inaccurately.

The Registrant agreed to complete course work on professionalism and documentation, pay a fine and provide employer references covering a total of 400 nursing practice hours. Conditions shall appear on the College register and on the Registrant’s practice permit.
